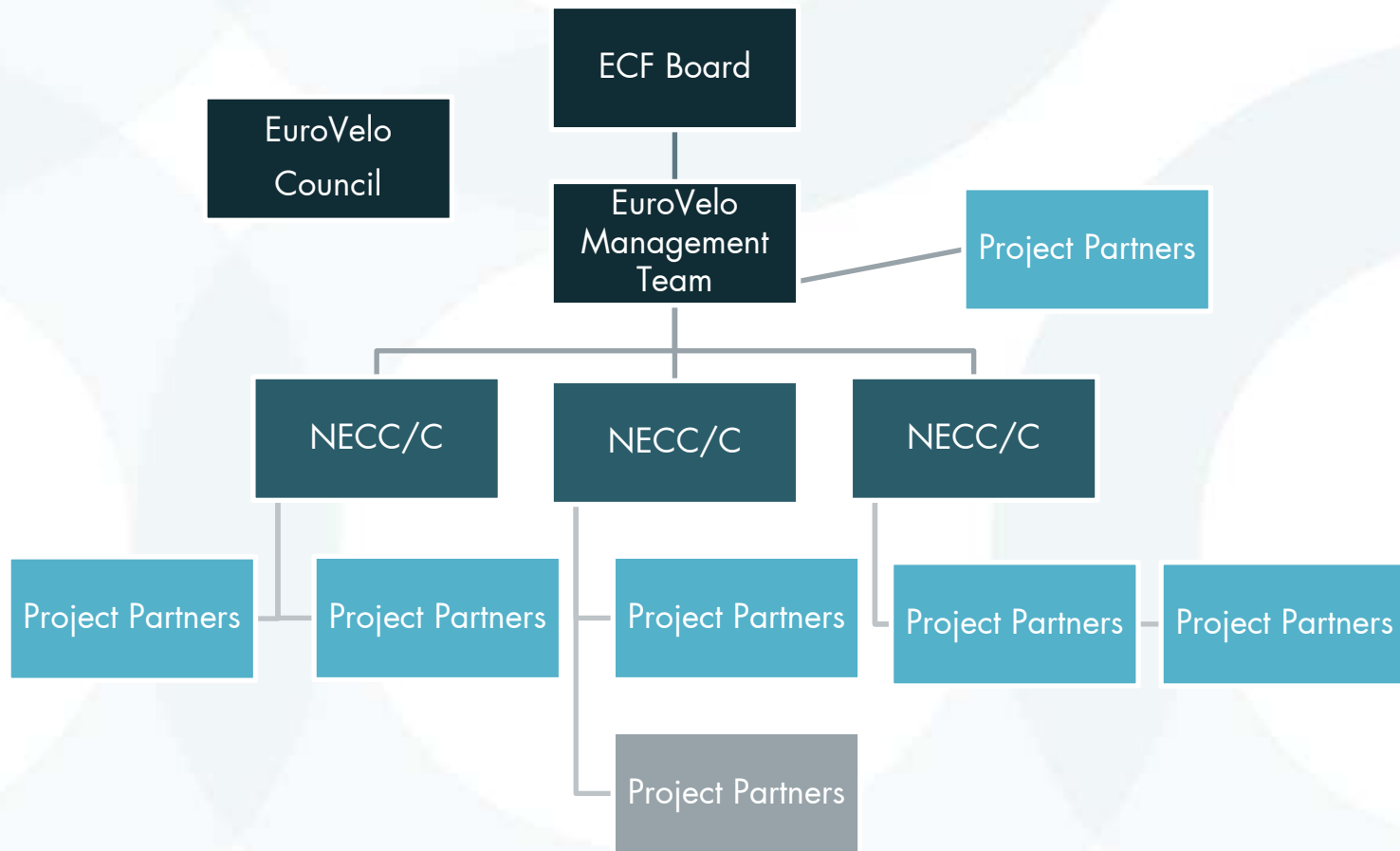




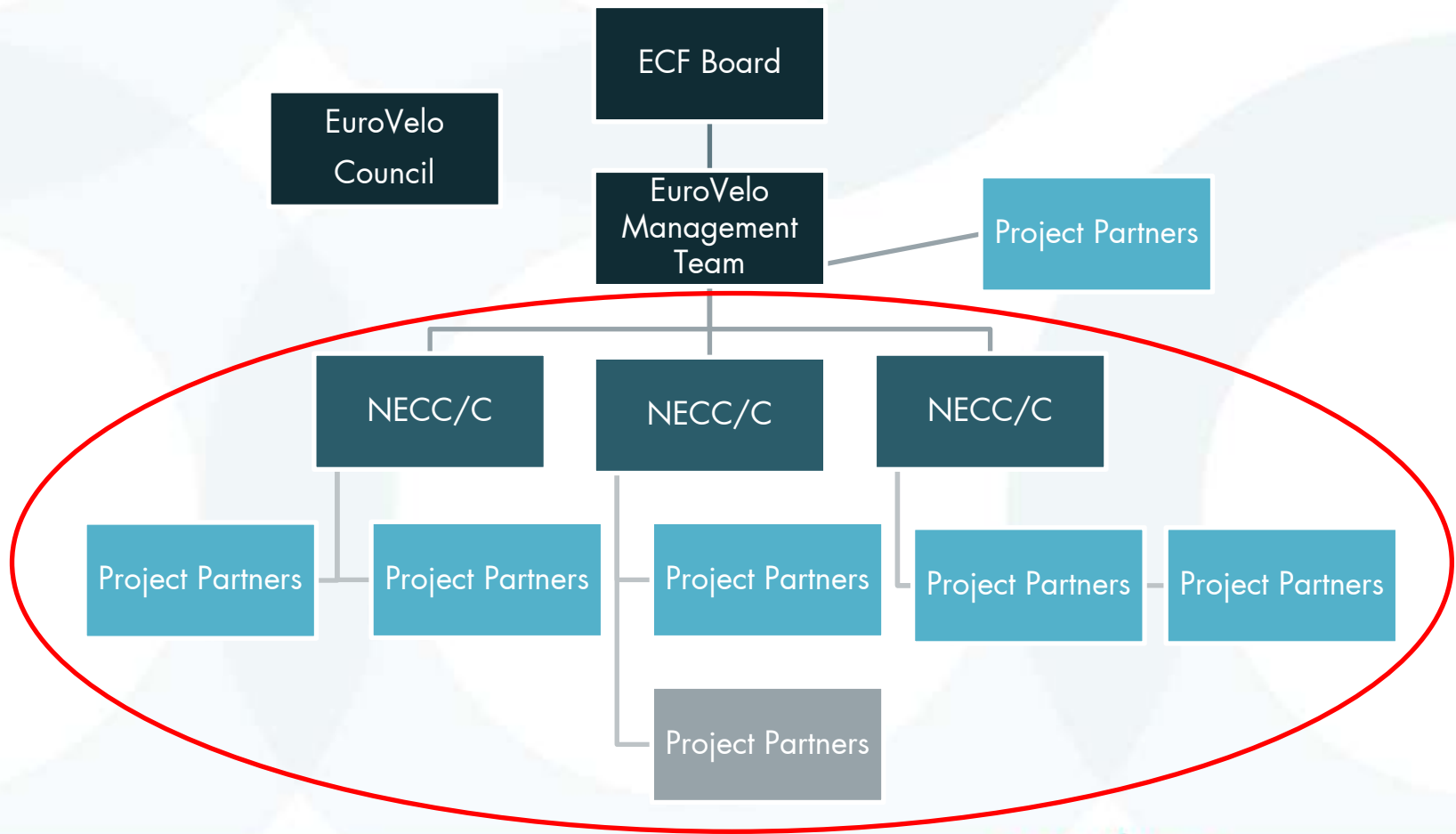

National EuroVelo Coordination Centres

Objectives

- Implementation, operation and quality control of the EuroVelo network at a national level.
- Develop the best organisational structure.
- Raise the national profile of EuroVelo.

National EuroVelo Coordination Centres

Consortium of representatives from:

- Relevant public bodies (national and regional)
- NGOs
- Public transport operators
- Service providers.

The exact composition will vary taking into account the circumstances in each country.

National EuroVelo Coordination Centres

Main Activities

- Route coordination
- Signposting coordination
- Communication
- Reporting



National EuroVelo Coordination Centres

Additional activities

- Network for services
- Transport connections
- Monitoring

National EuroVelo Coordinator

- Temporary position whilst establishing a Coordination Centre.
- Can be an individual, a single organisation or a couple of organisations.
- Roles and responsibilities similar to a Coordination Centre.

Regional EuroVelo Coordinators

Solution where establishing a NECC/C has been difficult due to:

- Geography
- Politics
- Coverage of relevant organisation(s).

Should be a temporary solution in most cases.

Regional EuroVelo Coordinators

Two level system:

1. National EuroVelo Coordination Centre round table
2. Regional EuroVelo Coordination Centre / Coordinators.
